State Bank of India invites Online application from eligible Indian citizen for appointment to the following Specialist Cadre Officers posts on regular basis. Candidates are requested to apply Online through the link given on Bank's website <https://bank.sbi/web/careers/current-openings>

1. The process of Registration is complete only when fee is deposited with the Bank through Online mode on or before the last date for payment of fee.
2. Before applying, candidates are requested to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria for the post as on the date of eligibility.
3. Candidates are required to upload all required documents (resume, ID proof, age proof, caste certificate, EWS Certificate, PWBD Certificate (if applicable), educational qualification, experience etc.) failing which their application/candidature will not be considered for shortlisting/ interview.
4. Short listing will be provisional without verification of documents. Candidature will be subject to verification of all details/ documents with the original when a candidate reports for interview (if called).
5. In case a candidate is called for interview and is found not satisfying the eligibility criteria (Age, Educational Qualification and Experience etc.) he/ she will neither be allowed to appear for the interview nor be entitled for reimbursement of any travelling expenses.
6. Candidates are advised to check Bank's website <https://bank.sbi/web/careers/current-openings> regularly for details and updates (including the list of shortlisted/ selected candidates). The Call (letter/ advice), where required, will be sent by e-mail only (no hard copy will be sent).

8. In case more than one candidate scores same marks as cut-off marks in the final merit list (common marks at cut-off point), such candidates will be ranked in the merit according to their age in descending order.

* A person who wants to avail benefit of reservation under section 34 of "The Right of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016" [Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD)] will have to submit a latest disability certificate issued by a Competent Authority as per Government of India guidelines. Such certificate will be subject to verification/ re-verification as may be decided by the competent authority. The certificate should be dated on or before last date of registration of application.

IMPORTANT POINTS:

1. The number of vacancies including reserved vacancies mentioned above are **provisional and may vary** according to the actual requirement of the Bank.
2. The educational qualification prescribed for the post are the minimum. Candidate **must possess the qualification and relevant full-time experience** as on specified dates.
3. Candidate belonging to Person with Benchmark Disabilities for whom no reservation has been mentioned are free to apply for vacancies announced for Unreserved/General category provided they fulfil all the eligibility criteria applicable to unreserved/General Category.
4. The reservation under various categories will be as per prevailing Government of India Guidelines.
5. PwBD candidate should produce a certificate issued by a competent authority as per the Government of India Guidelines.
6. Reservation for PwBD candidates is horizontal and is included in the vacancy of the respective parent category.

7. Vacancies reserved for OBC Category are available to OBC candidates belonging to '**Non-creamy Layer**'. Candidates belonging to OBC category but coming in creamy layer are not entitled to any relaxation/reservation available to OBC category. They should indicate their category as General or General (VI/HI/d&e), as the case may be.
8. OBC (Non-creamy layer) category candidate should submit the OBC certificate on **format prescribed by Govt. of India**, having Non-Creamy Layer clause issued during the period 01.04.2025 to the date of interview.
9. A declaration will have to be submitted in the prescribed format by candidates seeking reservation under OBC category stating that he/she does not belong to the creamy layer as on last date of online registration of application. OBC certificate containing the 'non-creamy layer' clause, issued during the period 01.04.2025 to the date of interview, should be submitted by such candidates, if called for interview. No request for extension of time for production of requisite certificate beyond the said date shall be entertained and candidature will be cancelled.
10. Caste certificate issued by Competent Authority on **format prescribed by the Government of India** will have to be submitted by the SC/ST/ OBC (Non-creamy layer) candidates.
11. Reservation for Economically Weaker section (EWS) in recruitment is governed by Office Memorandum No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dtd. 31.01.2019 of Department of Personnel & Training, Ministry of Personnel (DOPT), Public grievances & Pensions, Government Of India. Disclaimer: EWS vacancies are tentative and subject to further directives of Government of India and outcome of any litigation. The appointment is provisional and is subject to the Income & Asset certificate being through the proper channel.
12. EWS Benefit of reservation under EWS category can be availed upon production of an "Income & Asset Certificate" issued by a Competent Authority in the format prescribed by Government of India for the Financial Year 2024-25 and valid for the Year 2025-26, based on gross annual income as per extant DoPT guidelines. The EWS category candidate should be in possession of requisite Income and assets certificate in the format prescribed by Govt. of India in support of his/ her claim for availing reservation on the date of interview. **If a candidate fails to produce the 'Income & Asset Certificate' in the prescribed format on the date of document verification at the time of interview, candidate will not be allowed to attend the interview and he/ she will not be considered for appointment in the Bank for the post of Credit Analyst(MMGS III).**
13. The EWS candidates should note that in case, they are **not in possession of "Income & Asset Certificate"** for the relevant financial year as per the extant DOPT guidelines, such candidates **should apply under "General Category" only.**
14. **The relevant experience certificate from employer must contain specifically that the candidate had experience in that related field as required.**
15. Bank reserves the right to cancel the recruitment process entirely at any stage.
16. Maximum age indicated is for General category candidates. **Relaxation in upper age limit** will be available to reserved category candidates as per Govt. of India guidelines (wherever applicable).
17. Only those persons with benchmark disabilities would be eligible for reservation under PwBD category. 21. A. Visual Impairment (VI): Only those Visually Impaired (VI) persons who suffer from any one of the following conditions, after best correction, are eligible to apply.

a. Blindness:

- Total absence of sight; OR
- Visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; OR
- Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree.

b. Low Vision:

- Visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 upto 3/60 or upto 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible corrections; OR
- Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree up to 10 degrees.

B. Hearing Impaired (HI):

Hard of Hearing means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears.

C. 'd' & 'e': Only those persons, who suffer from any one of the following types of disabilities, are eligible to apply under this category: **MI/ASD/MD**

- “Mental Illness” (MI)** means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behaviour, capacity to recognise reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person, specially characterised by sub normality of intelligence.
- Autism Spectrum Disorder (Mild)- ASD (M):** Autism Spectrum Disorder means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person’s ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals or behaviours.
- “Multiple Disabilities (MD)”** means multiple disabilities amongst (a) to (d) above (TABLE-A)

Note: Only **Persons with Benchmark disabilities (PwBD)** would be eligible for reservation. **“Benchmark disability”** means a person with not less than **40% of a specified disability** (where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority).

NOTE: Cumulative age relaxation will not be available either under the above items or in combination with any other items. Candidates seeking age relaxation are required to submit copies of necessary certificate(s) at the time of document verification, if shortlisted. No change in the category of any candidate is permitted after registration of online application, no correspondence/email/phone will be entertained in this regard.

23. **CIBIL: Candidates who have defaulted in repayment under any lending arrangement with Banks/NBFCs/Financial Institutions including credit card dues and have not regularized /repaid their outstanding thereunder till the date of issuance of letter of offer of appointment by the Bank, shall not be eligible for appointment to the post. However, candidates who have regularized /repaid such outstanding on or before the date of issuance of offer of appointment, but whose CIBIL status has not been updated on or before the date of joining, shall have to either get the CIBIL status updated or produce the NOCs from lender to the effect that there is no outstanding with respect to the accounts adversely reflected in the CIBIL, failing which the letter of offer shall be withdrawn/cancelled. E. SELECTION PROCESS: The selection will be on the basis of Shortlisting and Interview.

- ❖ **Shortlisting:** Mere fulfilling the minimum qualification and experience will not vest any right to candidate for being called for interview. The shortlisting committee constituted by the Bank will decide the shortlisting parameters and thereafter, adequate number of candidates, as decided by the bank, will be shortlisted for interview. The decision of the Bank to call the candidates for the interview shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- ❖ **Interview:** Interview will carry 100 marks. The qualifying marks in interview will be decided by the Bank. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- ❖ **Merit List:** Merit list for selection will be prepared in descending order on the basis of scores obtained in interview only. In case more than one candidate score the cut-off marks (common marks at cut-off point), such candidates will be ranked according to their age in descending order, in the merit.

Candidates should first scan their latest photograph and signature. Online application will not be registered unless candidate uploads his/ her photo and signature as specified on the online registration page (under 'How to Upload Document'). iii. Candidates should fill the application carefully. Once application is filled-in completely, candidate should submit the same. In the event of candidate not being able to fill the application in one go, he can save the information already entered. When the information/application is saved, a provisional registration number and password is generated by the system and displayed on the screen.
